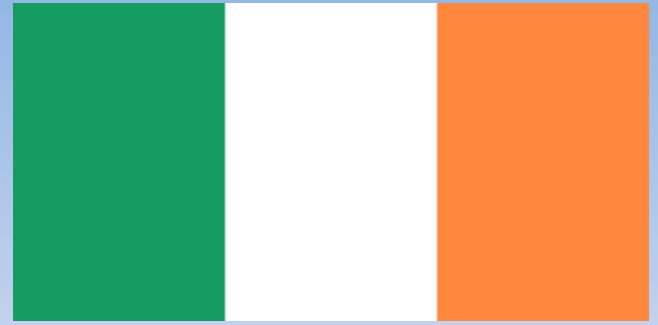

- Single sites are a legitimate version for Housing First
- Single sites can offer additional benefits for special target groups
- Rental contracts and support in one hand can be a prudent compromise in this context

Learning from Y-Foundation



- Great success is possible, when HF is the stable political mainstream
- HF can be the headline for very different types of housing and support
- Opinions can change, shelters can be remodelled and providers can learn

Learning from Arrels Fundacio



- Operating with moderate government support and mostly donations is possible
