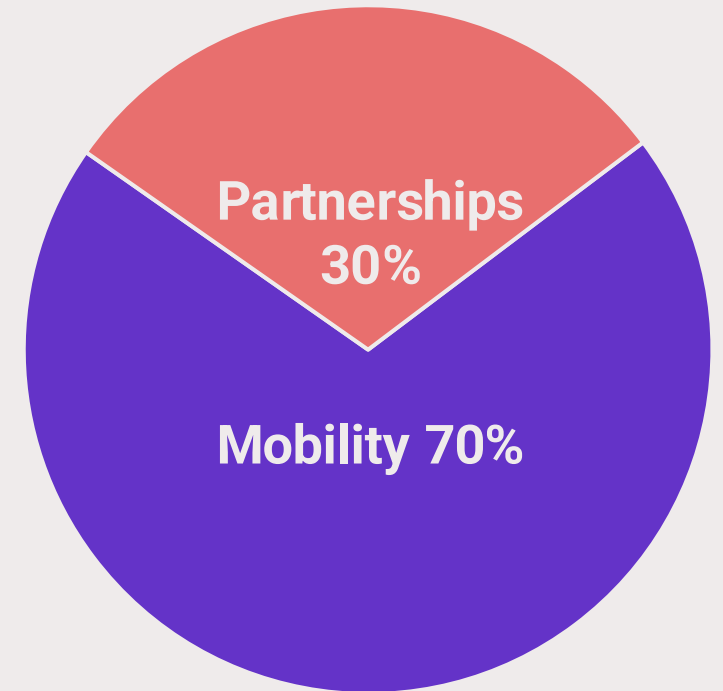

Partnership Projects

Work together with European partners to address common problems through cooperation, sharing best practices etc.

Leads to increased capacity, fosters skills development, enhances social inclusion etc.



Partnerships for Cooperation in brief

Partners

Minimum of one other European country involved

Duration

From six months up to three years

Funding

Lump-Sum Funding Model
€30,000, up to €400,000

Proportionality

Two types of projects: Small Scale Partnerships and Cooperation Partnerships
Impact & sharing are proportional to funding levels
